

Estonia's Support for Ukraine in Facts and Figures

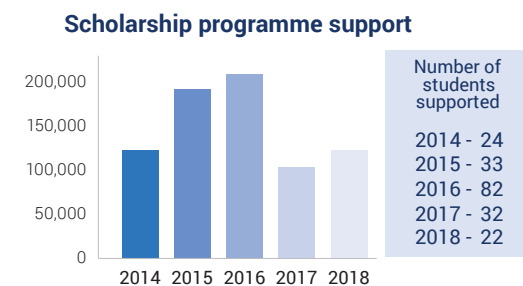
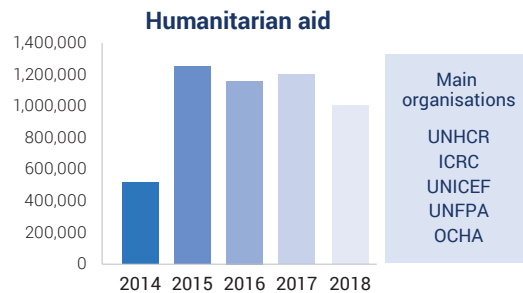
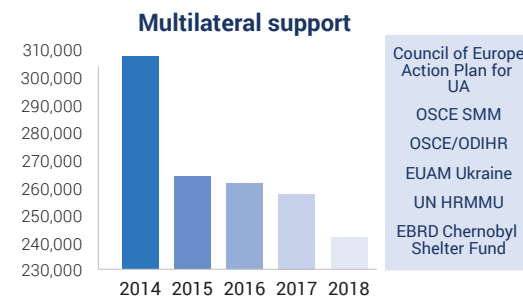
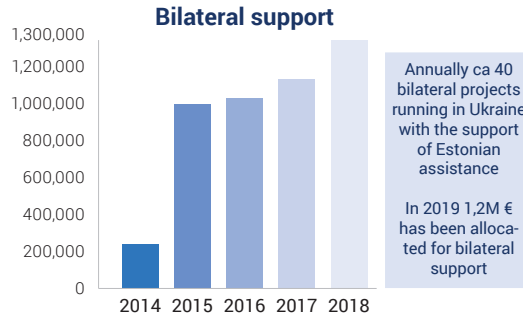
Ukraine has been a priority partner country for Estonia's bilateral development cooperation since 2006. Furthermore, Ukraine was the first beneficiary country in 1998 when Estonia started to provide bilateral aid. Throughout the years, Estonia has contributed over 13 million euros towards supporting Ukraine's development, out of which over 11 million (including also humanitarian aid) has been allocated between 2014–2018.

Bilateral cooperation programs support:

- Reform processes, good governance including e-governance and ICT solutions in public administration, anticorruption, improving strategic communication, regional development including resilience building in Eastern Ukraine, civil society capacity building.
- Business environment, creation of jobs incl job opportunities for IDPs, development of start-ups, agriculture.
- Education incl vocational education, development of curricula, ICT solutions in education system.

In 2018, Estonia contributed to the EU Advisory Mission in Ukraine (EUAM) with 5 experts, to the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission with 3 experts and to the EU Delegation with 2 experts.
